Margot Schulzke

Pastel demo

Margot Schulzke's name and her work are well known coast to coast. A longtime columnist for *The Pastel Journal*, she is widely regarded as an authority on the subject of composition and design. Her book, *A Painter's Guide to Design and Composition* (Northlight) was released to rave reviews in 2006. The highly respected Pastel Society of the West Coast has ranked her as a Distinguished Pastelist since 1988, an honor extended to only 26 of PSWC's approximately 400 members.

In 2006, the society added another signal honor, that of the PSWC Pastel Laureate™ Award. She is the fourth artist to be so honored. (The award is not given annually.) She was the subject of a feature article written by Christine Proskow in *The Pastel Journal* December 2008. Her work has been featured in a number of books and articles. She has served as a juror for many exhibitions, including the Pastel Journal Pastels 100 (2004).

She was also juror of awards for *Pastels USA 2008*, The Haggin Museum, Stockton, CA; the Northwest Pastel Society National Open Exhibition, Gig Harbor, WA, 2008; and the Emerald Art Center National Open Exhibition, April 2009; Juror of Selection, 3rd Annual Northeast National Pastel Exhibition, Old Forge, NY 2007; and Sierra Pastel Society International Pastels on High Exhibition, 2002. She is juror for the 56th Stockton Art League National

SAL Juried Art Show at The Haggin Museum starts Sept 2nd

Next year we will be celebrating SAL's 75th Anniversary-more than seven decades of promoting art appreciation in Stockton and San Joaquin County. From the very beginning we have had a strong relationship with The Haggin Museum. A group of local artists who had been meeting at the museum decided in late 1936 to formally organize the Stockton Art League. The newly formed League continued to meet at the museum, and held its first non-juried membership show there in November 1936, within weeks of organizing, with each member exhibiting two pieces.

In April 1945, the museum presented its first Juried Regional Art Contest, in which many SAL members participated, and which continued each fall until 1957. A juried show sponsored

by SAL was added to the museum's schedule in 1951, becoming known as the Stockton Art League Annual Spring Exhibition. Conceived to recognize, promote and reward excellence in San Joaquin County art, it is this show that has evolved into our current exhibition, becoming regional in 1965, and a Northern California show in 1984. After the 2004 show, the Exhibition became a biennial event, and was expanded to include five Western States. This is our second show as a national competition, offering more than \$5,000 in awards.

Of the 254 artists who submitted 670 pieces of art, 89 were accepted into this year's Exhibition, which
